He has received honors including the Presidential Guest and Watson-Jones Memorial Lecture of the British Orthopaedic Association, Hospital for Special Surgery Lifetime Achievement Award, and the Inaugural Award of the Society of Honorary Police Surgeons of the City of New York. He was inducted into the Johns Hopkins Society of Scholars, the German Society for Orthopaedics and Trauma, and serves as an Orthopedic Trauma specialist for the FDNY, the NYPD, and NY State Police. Dr. Helfet received a BSc in Biochemistry, M.B.Ch.B from the University of Cape Town, completed internship at Edendale Hospital in Pietermaritzburg, South Africa; residency at Johns Hopkins University; Trauma fellowship at the University of Bern/Insel Hospital, in Bern, Switzerland; and Sports Medicine Fellowship at UCLA.
